

RQT Programme 2021-22

Following the success of the RQT programme in 2020-21, Two Rivers Institute will be leading this programme of support and further professional development for teachers in their second and third years of teaching

Teachers are the foundation of the education system – there are no great schools without great teachers. Teachers deserve high quality support throughout their careers, particularly in those first years of teaching when the learning curve is steepest. As we are aware, the Early Careers Framework will roll out in schools nationally from September 2021. The aim of the framework is to build on Initial Teacher Training and provides a platform for future development. In order to support teacher adequately, professional development is likely to be sustained over time. The TRI RQT programme aims to give teachers in their second and third year the following:

- Opportunities to discuss evidence-based research
- Support within a collaborative environment
- Time to dedicate to their own professional development
- Access to high quality coaching in their own school setting. (Training for in school coaches provided separately)
